Discipline of Grace

Titus 2:11-2:14 *11For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men. 12It teaches us to say "No" to ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright and godly lives in this present age, 13while we wait for the blessed hope—the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, 14who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself a people that are his very own, eager to do what is good.*

1. OUR POSITION.

***Titus 2:13** while we wait for the blessed hope—the glorious appearing of our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ.*



2. THE INSTRUCTION

The manifestation of grace is preparing us for the manifestation of glory.

Grace teaching comes through two major avenues.

1. The Holy Spirit teaching us. 1 Corinthians 2:12-16.

2. Word of God teaching us. 2 Timothy 3:16-17.



Four responses to God's grace:

- 3. Hopeful outlook.**
- 4. Passion for His program.**



Practical Steps for Graceful Living.

Galatians 2:18-2:21 *19For through the law I died to the law so that I might live for God. 20I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. 21I do not set aside the grace of God, for if righteousness could be gained through the law, Christ died for nothing!"*
