love for you will never end, so says the LORD  
who loves you.*'

## **We are forgivable:**

Isaiah 43:25 "I, even I, am HE that blots out  
thy transgressions for mine own sake, & will  
not remember thy sins:'

## Paul

**2 Cori. 12:9** 9But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.
